- No sensitivity or allergy to bleach.
- Willing to work at any CHN Hospital to support a Network response to Serious Communicable Disease.
- Willing to be monitored at least twice daily for fever and other signs and symptoms during care of the patient and 21 days after exposure to an Ebola-positive patient. A checklist is utilized for monitoring signs and symptoms. One other person besides the associate must take one of the temperatures daily.
- Willing to abide by restrictions, including controlled movement (travel) and the potential use of public health orders, and quarantine for as long as 21 days post exposure as directed by the CDC.
